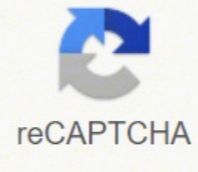

Past tenses revision

Past simple

- an action that happened at a definite time in the past. Last year we **bought** a dog.
- actions that happened immediately one after the other in the past. Lisa **took** a shower, **brushed** his teeth and **went** to bed.

Past continuous

- an action that was in progress at a stated time in the past. Yesterday at 4 I **was talking** to May on the phone.
- two actions that were happening at the same time. Lisa **was vacuuming** while her sons **were tidying** their room.
- an action that was in progress (longer action) when another action interrupted it. When I came in, Sue **was reading** .

Past perfect

- an action that happened before another action in the past. Before we left, we **had booked** a hotel room.
- complete past action that had visible results in the past. We felt relieved after they **had arrived** safely.

Past perfect continuous

- an action continuing over a period up to a specific time in the past. Peter **had been working** as a doctor for 25 years before he retired last year.
- action of certain duration that had visible results in the past. Mark **had been studying** Spanish for five years before he moved to Toledo.
